The Moody Church Ambassadors conduct evening gospel services for men and women on the second and third Wednesdays of each month. Volunteers support the services through prayer throughout the month and attend on the day of the service. All who have served as an Ambassador felt it is a privilege to serve the Lord and His people in this ministry. A volunteer can serve in most of the following positions:

Arrival time is between 6:00 to 6:15 p.m. to distribute programs with the songs and Scripture reading for the service. At 6:30 p.m., we assemble in the "Green Room" behind the platform for prayer before the 7:00 p.m. service begins.

Musicians and Vocalists of all talents to lead worship, accompany the leader instrumentally, or to provide inspirational music during the Offertory.

The Gospel Service

- **Welcome** opens the service by presenting a welcome greeting from the pulpit, which introduces the audience to the Moody Church, its location, times of service, and the evening's volunteers. This person invites those attending to come and experience worship and fellowship at the Moody Church.
- **Prayers** in two places in the program serve to bring everyone to the throne of God and focus on the service, scripture reading, and Gospel message.
- **Praise Hymns** worship God corporately and with soloists, if available.
- **Scripture Reading** from the King James or New King James Version is the passage on which the Preacher will bring his message. The verses are provided the serving group a few days in advance by email so the group can become familiar with them before the service.
- **Preaching the Gospel Message and Invitation** is a 30- to 35-minute evangelistic message from the King James or New King James Version. The purpose of the evening service is to preach salvation to the lost. The message must end by no later than 7:55 p.m. so the invitation to come forward can be given. Men who are gifted and called in this area are encouraged to attend at least two services.
- **Prayer Partners** consists of everyone participating in the service. In addition to Greeters, this is the greatest need for both men and women volunteers.

Pacific Garden Mission Dress Protocol

In keeping with its long tradition of conservative dress and behavior as examples to the men and women who are served at the mission, we who serve are asked to observe the following dress protocol:

Men:

- Business shirt with a collar and tie
- Dress slacks or business casual slacks
- If preaching, suit or sport coat
- No jeans, denim, shorts, sneakers, or sandals

Women:

- Modest length skirt or dress
- Dress slacks optional in inclement weather
- No jeans, denim, shorts, sneakers, or sandals
