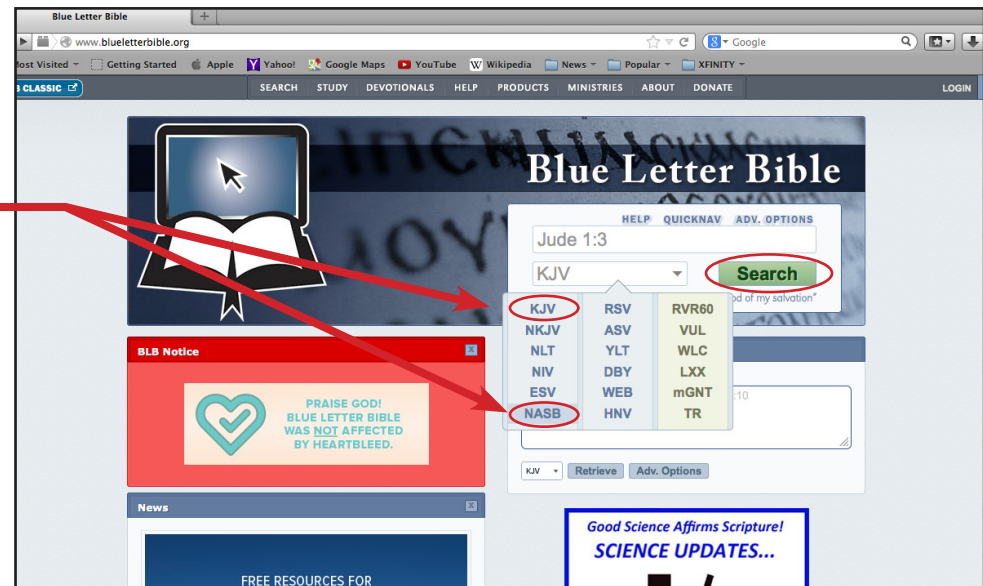

Then Select **Search**

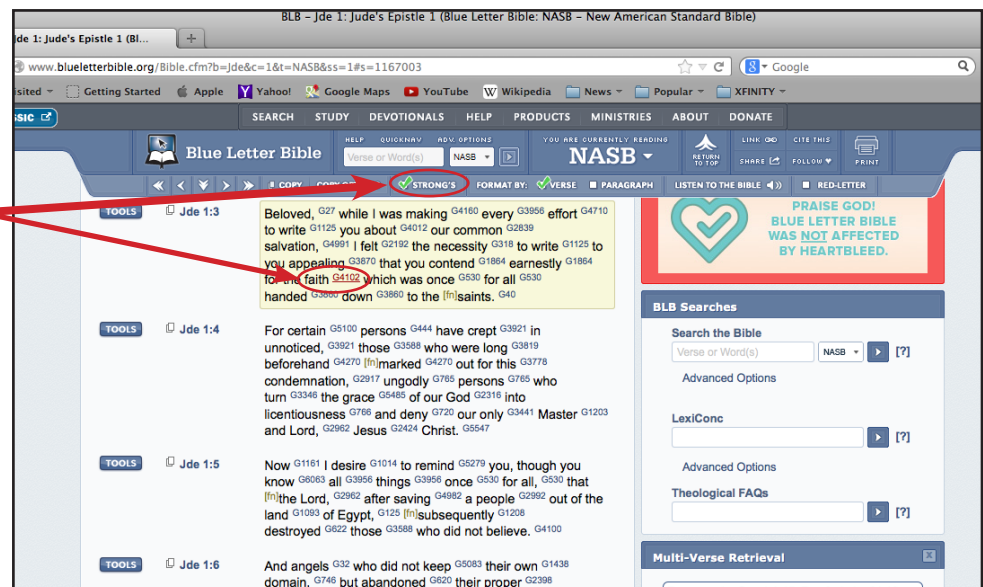

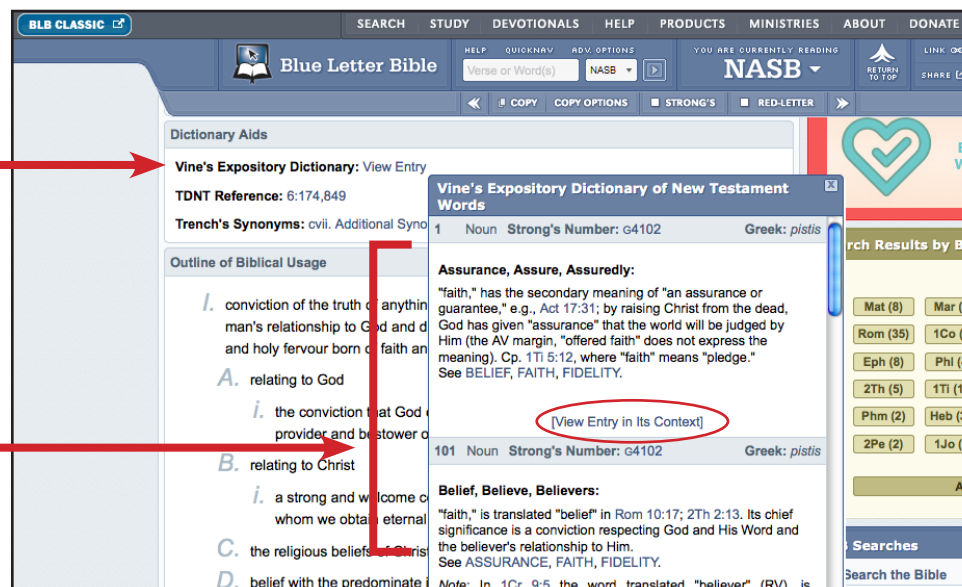
